Making a task to start a specific task with a particular palette

This lets you start a build command or something and have the palette be entirely different. Press win+alt+T to open Settings-->Startup-->Tasks and then add something like this

```
cmd.exe /k "gulp watch" -new_console:P:"^<Tomorrow Night^>" -new_console:d:D:\Code  
\BotLand\bot-land\client
```

The reason I'm including an example here is because the syntax is relatively atrocious for this. Plus, it won't call %ConEmuBaseDir%\CmdInit.cmd (which is helpful for getting the prompt that you're used to in ConEmu), so it's not the easiest to use since you'd have to make a custom CMD that calls both CmdInit.cmd and then your particular command.

Clearing scrollbar buffer

Troubleshooting

Prior to Windows 10, there's an issue where if you shrink ConEmu, you'll lose the contents of a CMD buffer. Upgrading to Windows 10 apparently fixes this.
